



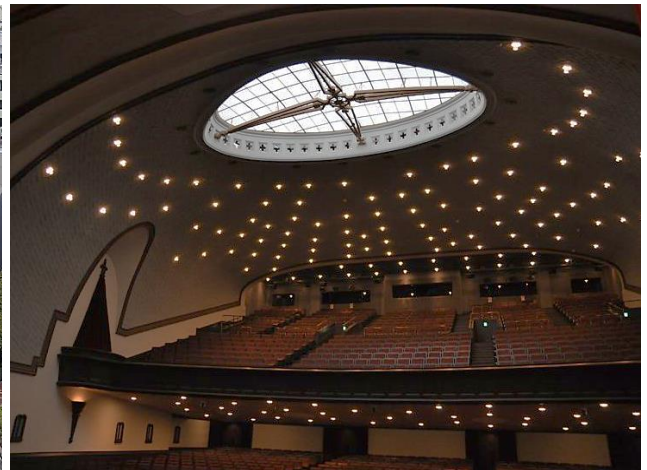

The 2023 Global Forum for Financial Consumers (GFFC), the 10th annual conference of the International Academy of Financial Consumers (IAFICO), will be held at Waseda University on July 27-28 in Tokyo, Japan. This year's theme for the GFFC will be "Building Resilient Financial Consumers: Protection in the Post-COVID Era".

The aim of 2023 GFFC is to establish an informative forum for academics, policymakers, and professionals from a diverse set of countries in order to share knowledge, experiences, and practical solutions of Financial Consumer Protection in the post COVID era.

KEY DATES

We look forward to your submissions of high-quality manuscripts that report empirical, experimental, or theoretical work. All the papers submitted will be reviewed.

Deadline for abstract submission: April 23

Notification for acceptance: May 23

Deadline for full paper submission: June 30

Abstracts should be submitted by **23 April** for review. Abstracts file should contain paper title, authors information (name, organization, job title, etc.). Acceptance decisions will be announced by **May 23**.

Full Papers will be due for submission by **June 30**. A selection of the papers from the conference will thereafter be invited for publication in the *International Review of Financial Consumers(IRFC)*. The full paper must include a page with the title of the paper, a list of authors, contact information for all authors, and their affiliations and positions.

Sungkyunkwan University Travel Scholarships (Conference Registration Fee + US\$300)

With financial support from Sungkyunkwan University, the IAFICO may offer travel scholarships to the persons who have paid for membership and who will present at the Global Forum for Financial Consumers.

We provide travel scholarships only to assistant professors or junior lecturers or doctoral candidates who will be presenting a paper onsite at the conference. In the case of joint research, the travel scholarship will be divided by the number of participants.
