How to Get to SKKU From Hotel


By Bus (approx. 30min):

- 1. From Shilla Stay Gwanghwamun, walk left to the main intersection.
- 2. Cross the street diagonally to the Jonggak / Gongpyeong Heritage Exhibition Hall bus stop.
- 3. Take Green Maeul (Village) Bus No. Jongno02
- 4. Get off after 11 stops at SKKU Rear Gate / Waryong Park
- 5. Walk downhill for about 10 minutes along the campus road. You will arrive at the Business School Building.

It takes about 10 minutes on foot along the campus road to reach the Business Building.


Check-in & Check-out Information

Check-in: From 14:00 on the day of arrival (Please visit the security office and present your ID or passport.)


Check-out: By 12:00 on the day of departure




How to Get to Venue from Business BLDG

Optional Seoul Sightseeing Recommendations

(All locations are easily accessible from Gwanghwamun area)

1.Changdeokgung Palace (창덕궁)

A UNESCO World Heritage site known for its beautiful secret garden and harmonious palace architecture.

2.Jongmyo Shrine (종묘)

A serene Confucaian shrine dedicated to the royal ancestors of the Joseon Dynasty, with deep historical siagnificance.

3. National Museum of Korean Contemporary History (대한민국역사박물관)

Located near Gwanghwamun, this museum offers a modern perspective on Korea's political, social, and cultural evolution.

4. National Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art – Seoul (MMCA 서울관)

Just behind Gyeongbokgung Palace, this museum showcases Korea's contemporary art alongside international exhibitions.

5. Hangang River (한강)

A scenic urban river with walking paths and parks — perfect for a relaxing stroll or riverside views of Seoul's skyline.
